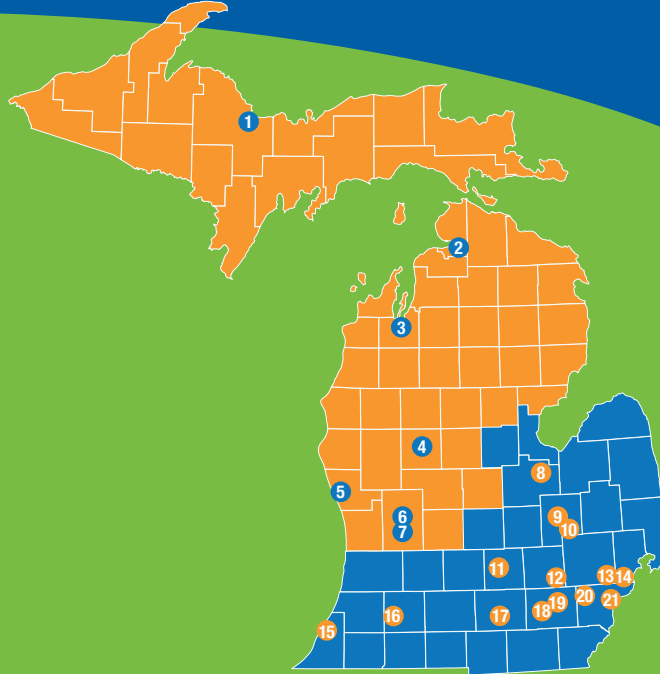


Each dollar spent on family planning in Michigan saves more than \$6 in public health care costs.

Addressing Health Care Disparities

African Americans comprise 14 percent of Michigan's population yet make up over half (57 percent) of those currently living with HIV/AIDS. The infant mortality rate among African Americans in Michigan is three times that of whites, and for Hispanics it's twice that of whites. The Michigan Department of Community Health reports that African Americans suffered 28 times the rate of gonorrhea as whites and 10 times the rate of chlamydia in 2008.
