



## Lizz Winstead Says “Planned Parenthood, I Am Here For You!”

Co-creator of The Daily Show and co-founder of Air America Radio, political satirist Lizz Winstead hit the road this summer in support of Planned Parenthood. Winstead launched her tour at the Historic Eagle Theater, next door to the Crofoot Ballroom in Pontiac, Michigan. Winstead, angered by the political attacks against women’s health care at the state and federal levels, planned the national tour “Planned Parenthood: I Am Here For You” to raise awareness, friends, and funds for Planned Parenthood.

A rally with over 50 attendees was held before the show to celebrate Planned Parenthood while anti-choice protesters protested across the street. Representative Gary Peters spoke before the show, giving an impassioned defense of Planned Parenthood and explained the importance of the services Planned Parenthood provides.

The packed venue filled with laughter as Winstead talked about today’s political climate and the direction of mainstream media. However, the atmosphere changed when Winstead told her story of when Planned Parenthood was there for her and the importance of a place that is there for women when they need it most.
