



14th Annual Ann Arbor Beer Tasting

For the 14th year, Ann Arbor celebrated women's health and reproductive rights at Arbor Brewing Company for Planned Parenthood Advocates of Michigan's Annual Beer Tasting. After fighting hard, Congress failed in their attempt to defund Planned Parenthood and remove access to care for the millions of women, men, and teens that Planned Parenthood serves throughout the country.
